Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

Within WP3, workshops were conducted with schools and associations, based on the *Remembr-House manual*.

The workshops involved the participation of project staff in assisting teachers in the implementation of the workshops. In the case of the associations, the staff directly implemented the activities. All the activities were carried out in on-site meetings, part at the schools' and associations' sites, part at MEIS headquarters.

Workshops with schools. Four institutes on the territory of Ferrara were involved: three secondary schools (Liceo Roiti - class V; Liceo Roiti - class III; Liceo Ariosto - class I; Liceo Ariosto - class II; IIS

Vergani Navarra - class III) and one first grade school (Scuola media Galilei Vigarano Mainarda), for a total of 154 students and 6 teachers (107 females, 53 males) between the ages of 12 and 18 years old. The workshops were held in May 2023 and between October and November 2023. In terms of duration, the workshops were calibrated based on the needs of the class: the modularity of the workshop constituted its characteristic feature, which facilitated its inclusion within the educational plan according to the needs of the individual class

Workshops with organisations working with teenagers/adults. Five trainings were conducted targeting associations in the Ferrara area and in Rovereto (TN). The training involved a total of 73 people (28 males and 45 females). The choice was to involve associations and aggregation centers that were very different from each other in nature, mission and age of the involved groups, by modulating the training while also respecting the vocation of each reality. The first training (November 14, 2023) was held at MEIS, targeting Carpa Aps Association and the Women's Documentation Center. Carpa Aps is dedicated to bringing young people closer to theatre and dramaturgy and aims at revitalizing the suburbs, and the Women's Documentation Center; it was established in 1980, it is one of Italy's longest-standing women's centers. The training was attended by 12 people (9 females, 3 males) ranging in age from 19 to 70 years old.

A second training was held on November 21, 2023 at the provincial and municipal (Ferrara) headquarters of AVIS, the Italian Blood Volunteers Association, and involved 14 of its associates (6 females and 8 males) between the ages of 60 and 75 years old. The third training was held on November 25, 2023 at the headquarters of AMF (Association of Musicians of Ferrara) and involved 3 people (2 males and 1 female) aged between 45 and 70 years old, musicians and teachers at the music school. On May 21, 2024, a training was held at the headquarters of the Jewish Community of Turin for participants of the trip organized by MEIS to discover Jewish Piedmont. It was an opportunity to introduce the project to people from all over Italy, with different backgrounds, ages and educational levels. The training involved 30 people (12 males and 18 females) ranging in age from 30 to 91 years old. The last training took place on May 27, 2024 at the Italian Historical Museum of War in Rovereto, it involved 14 people (11 females and 3 males) ranging in age from 22 to 50 years old, serving as educators and museum operators and teachers.

Due to the geopolitical situation brought about by the conflict in the Middle East and actual difficulties in carrying out the activities at the museum, the partners had requested an extension of the period in which to carry out the training and a greater range of engagement of schools and associations. The rescheduling was effective, and a good number of schools and associations were reached.

The WP3 activity, through carrying out the workshops together with the practitioners, made it possible to define and carry out the **guidelines for the implementation of the workshops** (D3.2 Hands on workshop guidelines) in which suggestions, practical advice and indications resulting from the fieldwork were collected for each phase of the workshop. An in-depth study by Prof. Caterina Di Chio was also included with respect to the management of some phases from a psychological point of view.

## The WP3 activity thus reached a total of 233 people (152 females and 81 males).

Trainings were also carried out in the Piedmont region (NOT calculated within the lump sum). We indicate those carried out at the headquarters of the 1563 Foundation addressed to the students of ISS "Soleri-Bertoni" in Saluzzo (40 students: 30 females, 10 males between 16 and 18 years of age), to the students of the Experimental Cinematographic Center - Turin (20 students: 12 females, 8 males); the workshop within SouXTorino - School of Architecture for children, carried out at the headquarters of the Polo del Novecento in Turin (12 children: 7 males, 5 females). Mention should also be made of the workshops carried out within the activities implemented for the two editions of the Turin Book Fair (2023-2024): the trainers carried out Remembr-House workshops remodelled to the characteristics of the fair with respect to timing and tools, involving three classes (two from the Turin area and one from Trentino Alto Adige); the trainers also carried out reading workshops with families and children under 10 years of age.
